

Hey, Mozart! Award Winner

John Paul Norman, Corrales resident and twelve-year-old student at St. Charles Borromeo School, is a winner in the 2007 Hey, Mozart! New Mexico competition. 106 pre-teens from throughout the state composed and submitted original melodies; sixteen winners were chosen. Winners will be recognized at a free public concert on September 7 at the National Hispanic Cultural Center, Disney Theater. Each winner will perform his or her melody; then the New Mexico Symphony Orchestra will play the orchestrated version which the young

composer will be hearing for the first time. Said Brookes McIntyre, president of Hey, Mozart! New Mexico, "We want to stimulate, recognize and reward creative thought in music. And we seek to foster the natural ability children have to create melodies."

John Paul Norman composed his winning melody on his recorder. He entitled it, "Stroll Through Boston, 1951". John Paul's parents were born in 1951; John Paul has never been to Boston. He is the son of Deborah and Paul Norman of Corrales.
